



### **SUPPLY LIST:**


To create your adventure book you will need the following:

- Cereal Box
- Glue Stick
- Tape

- Twine, Yarn or String
- Scissors
- Hole Punch


## **FRONT COVER:**

Using an empty cereal box, cut off the front and back panels of the box. Cut out the front cover below. Using a glue stick, glue the cover to the gray side of one of the cereal box panels and then cut out the front cover from the box.



## **BACK COVER:**

Cut out the back cover. Glue to the gray side of a cereal box panel and then cut out the back cover.




### **HOW TO ASSEMBLE YOUR BOOK:**

Once your front and back covers have been glued to the cereal box, place the back cover on the bottom, facing down and the front cover on the top, facing up. Use a hole punch to punch two holes on the left side of the book.



Cut the inside book pages in half and place in a pile. Punch holes in the left hand side of the stack.




Place the pages between the book covers, lining up the holes. Use twine or yarn to tie the book shut as pictured below:



#### To create the pocket pages:

Cut along the diagonal line on the pocket page.



Tape the bottom and side to the next page as shown below:



Now it's time to fill out your book! As you head out on adventures near and far, bring your book along to keep track of all of the fun things you do!
